On a day when playing to your handicap didn't guarantee a voucher the next best players were Mark Bolton with 2 up and 1 ups to Jeff Hall, Mumfy, Dean Woolford, Joe Marcus and Larger than Life himself Graham Edwards.

The Pro comp went to Hugh Griffin for his 4 up back nine helped by his remarkable closing six holes and he shared the eagles nest with Happy Gilmour who nailed the 8th in three shots.
