Mary Langsford from a long distance out from the flag, hit the pin three times but the ball was not interested in falling in, but chose to run 2-3 feet past the flag.

Karyne Scheer amazingly had six three pointers in a row and was a standout in the fashion stakes, while Suzanne Antel had an absolute wardrobe malfunction when after 2-3 hole realised her golf top was worn inside out!

Robyn Teasdale found some over-due golf form and putted off the green on the 16th fairway to close the hole out for a six. Fran Henschke had 19 on the front nine, seven three pointers and two wipes for her 35 Stableford card.

Biddie Freeman shot through the trees on the 15th, never disturbed a leaf, and finished the hole for a 5.

It was most pleasing to see Karen Kneebone take to the course and her playing partners praised her drives, fairway shots and encouraged more work needed with the putter. Welcome Karen.

Saturday 23/3 winner of the day was Cathy Thomas with 33 points, next best were Marg Bessen 32 and Ellen Paech 31.
